

Downloading the GWS Library

1. To obtain the GWS library of S-Plus functions, go to <http://faculty.smu.edu/hgray/software.html>. Click on the filename "GWSxxxxxxx.zip". ("xxxxxxx" will be the date of the latest version of GWS.) You may click "Save" or "Open".
2. Use whatever Zip utility program you wish (e.g., WinZip* or the built-in Windows XP Zip utility) to extract the files. Extract the files to your S-Plus program's library folder. Be sure that you extract all the files and that folder names are preserved. (There should be options like "All Files" and "Use folder names" on the Zip utility you are using.) In most cases, the appropriate location will be

C:\Program Files\Insightful\splusXX\library,

where "XX" is the version of S-PLUS installed on your computer (e.g., "splus62" or "splus70"). You can also extract the files wherever you choose and then copy the extracted "GWS" folder to this location.

3. The GWS library is now downloaded to your computer and should be available to load. For further help with the GWS library and its modules, please see the Library Instructions.

* WinZip is a free software package for windows that allows users to zip and unzip files. To obtain WinZip, go to the WinZip home page located on the web at <http://www.winzip.com/>.
